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


XW100 Wireless Module









#### 1. Creating a new network

#### Follow these steps to create a new network using your XW100 Wireless Module

- 1. Release the alarm from its mounting plate using a screwdriver
- 2. Insert the wireless module in the host alarm by placing it in the cavity on the rear of the alarm; ensuring the antenna is on the side with the exposed connectors
- 3. Fold the antenna between the outer rim and module casing
- Reactivate the alarm by sliding it back onto the mounting plate until it clicks
- 5. Press the button on the front of the alarm twice
- **6.** The blue LED will flash indicating how many alarms are present in the network. Long flash = 5 alarms, short flash = 1 alarm
  - Eg. 7 alarms =  $1 \times long flash + 2 \times short flash$
  - 3 alarms = 3 x short flash
- **7.** Repeat for each alarm to go into the network
- **8.** When the number of flashes on each configured alarm indicates the correct number of modules present in the network, the configuration session can be completed by pressing the alarm button once, providing the alarm has been turned on for more than 30 seconds
- 9. Your XW100 Wireless Module is now functioning correctly

#### 2. Adding a XW100 Wireless Module to a network

### Follow these steps for adding a XW100 Wireless Module to a network

- 1. Release the alarm from its mounting plate using a screwdriver
- 2. Insert the wireless module in the host alarm by placing it in the cavity on the rear of the alarm; ensuring the antenna is on the side with the exposed connectors
- **3.** Fold the antenna between the outer rim and module casing
- **4.** Release an alarm already in the network from its mounting plate using a screwdriver
- Turn the alarm already in the network over and press the wireless module button three times
- **6.** Press the wireless module button on the new alarm three times
- **7.** The blue LED will flash indicating how many alarms are present in the network. Long flash = 5 alarms, short flash = 1 alarm
- **8.** When the number of flashes indicates the correct number of alarms in the network, press the button on both modules for 3 seconds to end the configuration procedure
- **9.** I FDs on both will flash for about 30 seconds
- **10.** Your XW100 Wireless Module is now functioning correctly
- **11.** Repeat for each alarm to go into the network
- 12. Reactivate the alarms by sliding them back onto their mounting plate until it clicks
